Area Director – Position Description

The Area Director represents one of the six (6) geographical areas within the South Patrick Residents Association (SPRA). The Area Director is an elected position and each is a member of the Board. Each one acts as a liaison from their assigned area to the Board and membership. Their contact information is published in the *Shore News* and on the website at www.spranews.com

Authority: Bylaws, Article II, Section 3

- Elected by the membership at the Annual meeting.
- Reports to the President.
- Serves a one (1) year term and may be re-elected. (The Fiscal year is January 1 to December 31)
- In case of a vacancy, the President will appoint a new area director.

Duties:

- 1. Regularly attends SPRA meetings. If unable to attend should notify the President.
- 2. Survey appointed area for code violations or unlawful activities and checks entrance ways and medians for maintenance. Makes regular reports about activities and/or needs within the area at scheduled meetings. The report may be oral or written.
- 3. Serves as the contact source for residents within their geographical area.
- 4. Appoints any committees needed for special projects or maintenance within area.
- 5. Required to get approved from the Board prior to any expenditure or obligations for repairs, maintenance, or new purchases.
- 6. Required to provide receipt to the Treasurer for any reimbursement for approved expenditure.
- 7. Encouraged to attend County Commission meetings, when the SPRA area is involved and report back to the Board.
- 8. Selects the Yard of the Month (YOM) by the 10th of the month prior to the *Shore News* publication date and reports the selection to the *Shore News* editor. A photo of the yard should be provided. (YOM is optional)
- 9. Secures permission to place the YOM sign in home owner's yard, placing and removing the sign in a timely manner. (YOM is optional)
